### A Day On Trail With Wilderness Trail

Early! :)	Staff wakes up the group to break down tents and pack up.
Breakfast time	The group eats breakfast together.
	Quiet Time led by the Staff.
	Hiking! Individuals travel at their own pace between a "point" person in the front and a "sweep" person at back. The group stops periodically for snacks or to enjoy a nice view.
Lunchtime	The group stops to have lunch together, sharing peanut butter, honey, crackers, and more.
	Hiking again!
Afternoon	The group arrives at camp. Hikers set up tents, play, rest, gather firewood, and/or help pump water.
Dinnertime	The Staff prepares a meal for the group and they all eat together.
Evening	The group gathers for campfire. They sing together, share "Little Foxes" and "Holy Ground" from the day, and the Staff leads a devotion - usually around the Summer's theme.

2:30	Wiffle Ball and other games at our infamous Weaver Field.
4:00 - 5:15	More free time, or meeting in hiking groups (if they have not done so already).
5:15	Group skits, Trail Blazer Club (150+ miles with W.T.) and W.T. Museum
6:30	Dinner
7:30	Worship
8:00	5 <sup>th</sup> Night Campfire (Worship Continues in Hiking Groups)
