Who can come to the Work Days?

- Anyone and everyone is welcome! No skills are necessary.
- Youth (who have yet to graduate from high school) must be accompanied by a parent or responsible adult. WT will not provide supervision for youth or children.
- There will be plenty of fellowship and fun, but apart from brief evening devotions, no programming.

How much does it cost?

- Nothing! What a deal! Contributions to help defray costs are welcomed but not required.

When should I arrive and leave?

- Volunteers are free to arrive anytime from Thursday evening to Saturday morning. Most volunteers arrive Friday evening. Please give a courtesy call if your arrival time changes so we do not fret.
- Volunteers are free to leave whenever they need to. Most volunteers leave Saturday evening or Sunday morning. The latest departure time is noon on Sunday.
- Directions can be found on our web site; there is little cell phone coverage in our area, so plan your route ahead of time.

What should I bring?

- Food for the weekend. The kitchen and grill will be available. WT will provide basic utensils, paper products, coffee, and coolers of water and lemonade. A cooler is not necessary, but may keep your food neat and organized.
- A sleeping bag and pillow. The Lodge, Shelters, and Cabins will be open. Personal tents and/or campers are welcomed.
- A towel and shower supplies, if you plan to shower!
- Old clothes to work in; we will be cleaning, doing yard work, sitting around the fire, etc.
- Warm clothes! The average low in April is 36 degrees. The average high is 63. You might enjoy having a hat, gloves, and extra layers for the evenings.
